BEGINS SEPTEMBER 29**

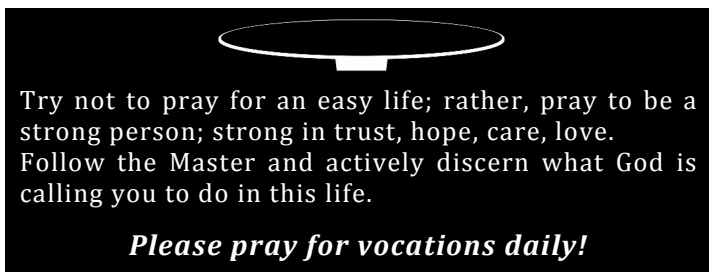
