

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Your child will have the opportunity to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion this year. In an effort to adequately prepare your child to receive these blessed sacraments, there are some requirements your child **must** meet to be qualified. Below are the requirements and expectations:

1. Attendance
 - a. Your child will allowed no more than 1 absence per semester.
 - b. Parents are expected to notify the communion teacher by email/text or phone if their child is going to be absent prior to class.
 - c. More than 1 unexcused absence may delay your child in receiving the sacrament.

2. Attendance to mass
 - a. Students are expected to attend **weekend mass and holy days of obligation.**
 - b. Students are required to sign in at the first communion log in the foyer beginning in January.
 - c. If a student attends another Catholic church other than Holy Trinity, they are expected to bring a bulletin as confirmation of their attendance to mass. This should be given to his/her CCE teacher the following Wednesday for proper attendance tracking.

3. Attendance to the Jesus Day
 - a. All students along with a parent are expected to attend the scheduled Holy Trinity Catholic Jesus Day.

4. Reconciliation
 - a. All students are expected to attend reconciliation no less than one week prior to receiving their First Holy Communion.

5. Adoration
 - a. Students along with a parent will be required to attend one hour of adoration at Holy Trinity.
 - b. Adoration is held the first Saturday of each month from 9-5 pm.
 - c. Students must sign in/out.

Receiving the sacraments is a privilege. We are making every effort to adequately prepare students and will use these requirements as well as their understanding of the educational material to determine a student's readiness and eligibility to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.
