BUILDING PROCESS UPDATE....



Ground Breaking Ceremony: Come celebrate another big milestone in our building process by joining Monsignor Michael Jamail and Father Khanh for the groundbreaking ceremony which will start shortly after 10:30 Mass on Sunday, August 27.

Final Clean-up Effort: Also on Sunday, August 27, we will have our final clean-up effort following the groundbreaking ceremony. You have probably noticed the building getting emptier, but we have a few more things to do to complete our move. Please join us as we finish preparing our current building for the new construction project.

Rocks for the Foundation: Be a part of our building expansion by putting your name and/or prayer intention on a river rock that will go into the concrete as the foundation is poured. We have a limited number of rocks available on a first come basis after the 6pm and 8:30am Masses, and at the groundbreaking ceremony.

Mass Survey Results: Thanks to everyone who participated in the Sunday Mass survey last weekend. We had a total of 159 responses representing input from all three current Masses. The majority of responses voted for our Sunday Masses to be held at 7:30am and 9am during the construction. Here are the results:

7:30am and 9am = 107 responses

9am and 1pm ==22 responses

9am and 5pm = 30 responses

Start Date for New Mass Times and Location: Beginning Labor Day Weekend (September 2 and September 3), we will be moving Saturday and Sunday Masses across the street to the First United Methodist Church. The Mass times will be 6pm on Saturday with Sunday Masses at 7:30am and 9am. Daily Masses will be held in Holy Trinity parish office.

Parking at the Methodist Church: The Methodist congregation has gone out of their way to welcome us as we share their church. For example, they are moving their 9am services on Sunday to the Fisher Chapel so that we can celebrate Mass at the same time in the big church. Out of respect, those of us attending 9am Mass on Sundays should park in our Holy Trinity parking lot and walk across the street. You can always drop your family off at the Methodist church, then park. Thank you for helping us be good neighbors!

PASTORAL COUNCIL **AUGUST UPDATE**

The Pastoral Council met on August 15. We discussed the parish's Facebook page, and method of posting with Karen Banks and Leah Courville (site administrators). The council agreed to assist in getting the word out to parish organizations asking for a point of contact from each organization to ensure information is being disseminated efficiently utilizing the Facebook page. Leah presented an idea supporting the monthly Children's Mass, including information and activities available for the children at church—look for this with completion of the expansion. Karen, as the new Mardi Gras Festival director, asked for guidance and agreement on the timing and scope of next year's festival—this will be a business item for the next meeting. Father Khanh's focus for the council (and parish) this year is evangelization. One idea we are pursuing is a First Responders Mass—but due to the upcoming move as guests of the First United Methodist Church, we may wait until 2018 to make this happen. Our monthly meetings are scheduled for the 1st Thursday of each month at 6:30pm, and will be held in the LeBlanc Building during the expansion project. The next meeting is scheduled for September 7.
