## BUILDING PROCESS UPDATE....



The contract for our building expansion has been signed and is in place. However, in light of all the damage caused by Hurricane Harvey, Father Khanh and the Building Committee Chairs, James Prochazka and David Workman, decided to delay construction. This will allow the Diocese and our construction company to focus their attention on the parishes that suffered significant damage to their church buildings. In addition, our construction superintendent resides in Labelle and suffered severe damage to his home. The delay will allow more time to recover from the devastation caused by the hurricane.

The building permit with the City of Mont Belvieu will not be affected by the delay. Our new target date for beginning construction is November 2, 2017, depending on the condition of the Diocese at that time. Our building subcommittees will continue planning the various aspects of the transition during the building process, as well as continuing their scope of work in planning for the new expansion.

During this delay in construction, weekend and daily Mass will continue to be celebrated during our usual times at our current church. Thank you for your support for our parish family and for your continued prayers for those affected by the floods.
