PASTORAL COUNCIL NOVEMBER UPDATE

The Pastoral Council met on November 2. We discussed the Evangelization Committee's request regarding a mailing list of parish veterans for the annual card campaign. We decided to sponsor a Ministry weekend to solicit volunteers for all parish ministries. Another topic from the Evangelization Committee was Visitor cards (which will be re-stocked and provided to visitors at the end of Mass). Cesar Morales's son is planning an Eagle Scout project to improve the Grotto area. We discussed the upcoming move to our temporary location—separate announcement pending by the building committee. The Boy Scouts of America will be highlighted at an upcoming Mass. The Diocesan Conference of Catholic Leaders will be held August 17-18, 2018. Its focus will be on Evangelization and Pope Francis's "The Joy of the Gospel". Our monthly meetings are scheduled for the 1st Thursday of each month at 6:30pm, in the church classroom (and will be held in the LeBlanc building during the expansion project). The next meeting is scheduled for December 7.
