Construction is scheduled to begin on Monday, January 8, 2018. Before then EVERYTHING inside the church needs to be removed

- **Saturday, Jan. 6, 2018 at 8:00 am** – Moving day. We need a LOT of willing hands to help move everything out of the current church (except the chairs and altar in the sanctuary) in preparation for the construction. Please plan on joining us for this important work day.
- **Sunday, Jan. 7, 2018 after the 10:30 Mass** we will finish removing chairs, the altar, and sound system.

MASS SCHEDULE

January 1 through January 7, 2018 – Daily Mass will be held in the **church** all week and the weekend of January 6/7, 2018.

Beginning January 9, 2018 – Daily Mass will be held in the temporary chapel located at the parish office. Mass times will be the same as the current schedule: Tuesday at 6:00 pm and Wednesday through Friday at 8:00 am. This new chapel will also be used for Adoration, baptisms, and Stations of the Cross.

January 13/14, 2018 – We will have Saturday/Sunday Mass at the LeBlanc Building. Saturday Mass will be at 6:00 pm. Sunday Masses will be at 7:00 am, 9:00 am, and 11:00 am.

Beginning January 20/21, 2018 (tentative dates) – We will celebrate Mass at the M.L. Wismer Distributing Company located at 12357 Interstate 10 East in Mont Belvieu, Texas, 77523. Mass times will be the same as we have today – Saturdays at 6:00 pm and Sundays at 8:30 am and 10:30 am. In addition, reconciliation will be available at the Wismer facility on Saturdays at 5:00 pm to 5:45 pm. Maps and directions to the Wismer facility will be provided.
